Welcome back!

It's been a long, quiet summer without you all! We're so glad you're back on campus. Here's a quick guide to some of the changes you'll see in the library:

- **Staff changes:** This summer we bid farewell to two librarians: Ms. Bailey, who's now working at Union College, and Mrs. Rodriguez-James, who has moved to Loma Linda University. They've left big shoes to fill, but watch this space to find out who will step in and take over their roles.
- **Charging stations:** If you find you're running a little low on power, we've got you covered — we now have three charging stations available, each with a variety of eight cords (see right). One is on the mezzanine, directly opposite the main staircase; one is by Mrs. Neath-Foster's office, on the main floor; and the third is near the BT section in the central seating area, also on the main floor.
- **Whiteboards:** In addition to the large freestanding whiteboards, we now have three smaller whiteboards that you can wheel around. Dry-erase markers are still available at the front desk for 75¢ each.
- **Printing:** We have some new printers in the Copy Center, and every computer in the library (except the six guest computers upstairs) is wired to print to them. You'll also be able to copy and scan on those machines. Let us know if you experience any difficulties.
- **Welcome table:** Sometimes people feel like the library isn't a very welcoming place. To combat that, we're setting up a "welcome table" in the front lobby where you can grab a coloring page, let us know how we're doing, and weigh in on heavy issues, like "What's the best flavor of Pringles?"
